CHAMPAGNE

Grower Champagne, or "farmer fizz" as it is sometimes endearingly called is one of the most exciting markets in the current wine world. The Champagne industry is historically based on very large companies who buy grapes, juice, wine or finished Champagne and blend it to produce their signature house style. While this creates a consistent product it tends to lose the subtleties of small specific areas within Champagne.

Grower Champagne delves into the flavors of each of the areas of Champagne, delivering a style of wine that speaks of its specific origin within the Champagne area. The farmers below all own their own land, grow their own grapes, make their own wine and produce their own Champagne. Often due to small family holdings these wines are produced in extremely small quantities.

2005 ALAIN CHAVY Puligny-Montrachet (Burgundy, France)

Alain Chavy took over from his father Gérard Chavy and has continued to elevate his domain to the finest in the Côte d'Or. The Chavy's have been vignerons in Burgundy for over 200 years, but only bottling their own wines since 1986. Chavy's style focuses on honing the minerality of the vineyards and with minimal oak use allowing the wines to express their site specific traits. Certainly considered to be at the top of Puligny producers, Chavy's wines are full of rich mineral nuances.

2003 ZIND-HUMBRECHT Riesling Heimboung ~Indice 1~ (Alsace, France)

Olivier Humbrecht is a towering figure, not only in his physical stature, but in his standing within the international winecommunity. Considered one of the wine world's greatest winemakers, Oliver Humbrecht fashions wine much like his own self...brooding, intensely concentrated, earth driven and maniacally focused on the taste of terroir. The Heimboung vineyard, which used to be part of the Grand Cru Brand, is situated near the village of Turckheim. The soil here is rocky limestone giving the wine a light chalky minerality and a firm structure. The wine is dry offering superb notes of apple, meadow flower and a hint of camphor.

2005 WALTER HANSEL Chardonnay Cuvée Alyce (Russian River Valley, United States)

Walter Hansel began in 1978 when he planted 250 vines in the Russian River Valley as part of a burgeoning wine hobby. Walter's son Stephan is now in charge of the family business (which also has several car dealerships) and has built the estate up to 80 acres under vine. The wines are typified by their very pure mineral notes balancing the power and concentration that Russian River Valley can deliver. Superbly executed oak use mixed with supple acids and joyful fruit sweetness. For lovers of Chardonnay this is an exceptional drink.

2006 PARAS VINEYARD Viognier (Mount Veeder, United States)

Jim Paras, a lawyer hailing from San Francisco, loved the wines and scenic virtues of Napa Valley so much he felt he had to be part of it. He created Jade Mountain and hired the talented Douglas Danielak to make the wines. Jade Mountain took off and the label was soon acquired by Chalon group. Paras sold the name but kept the vineyards (always the best deal) and created Paras Vineyards, still retaining Danielak's winemaking skills. The Paras Vineyard Viognier is a decadent romp through masses of warm super ripe apricot, walls of white lily, platefuls of crème caramel and waterfalls of honey. For those who cherish decadence.

2004 AU BON CLIMAT Pinot Noir Le Bon Climat (Santa Maria Valley, United States)

Jim Clendenen has been making wine in California for over 25 years and a master producer of Pinot Noir. He purchased the 100 acre Le Bon Climat vineyard in 1998. The vines are tended for in a care giving organic way (certified in 2003) and Clendenen utilizes gentle grape processing for pure varietal expressions. This soulful Pinot Noir offers the delicate nuances of morello cherry, riverbed mineral with supple acids and just firm tannins. A very pure California Pinot Noir

2005 ACHALVAL-FERRER Quimera (Mendoza, Argentina)

Achaval-Ferrer came to life in 1998 with the mixing of two cultures and six friends. Italy and Argentina united to create, in 10 short years, one of the world's greatest estates. Wines of Argentina are known for their power and grace, sitting side by side, these two components make the wines of Argentina both new world in concentration and old world with delineated acidity and grace on the palate. Nowhere else in Argentina do these two elements combine with such balance. Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot comprise the blend and give way to sweet violets, mature plum, dark black currents and supple cedar and mocha.

2005 TUA RITA Guisto di Notri (Tuscany, Italy)

Tua Rita, the transposition of the owner's name Rita Tua, was first farmed in 1984 with the help of her partner Virgilio Bisti. Stephan Chioccioli, one of Italy's most regarded oenologists, was acquired to handle the wines. Based in Suvreto on the Tuscan coast Tua and Bisti planted Bordeaux varietals focusing on Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. The wines themselves combine all the best aspects of Napa Valley and Bordeaux, entrenched with the Italian flare for rich mineral nuances and powerful fruit concentration. Scorched earth, almost over-ripe black currents, pure cedar and fresh ground coffee.

2005 SINE QUA NON Atlantis Fe 203 1A Syrah (California, United States)

One would be hard pressed to find a harder wine to secure than Elaine and Manfred Krankl's Sine Qua Non. The name itself Sine Qua non means, an essential element or something one cannot be without. Seems fitting for such an awe inspiring wine. The couple is based in the back roads of Ventura, while still purchasing some fruit they farm greater amounts each year from their Eleven Confessions vineyard. A perfect wine in many eyes, this elixir of Syrah will float on your palate deepening its pressure as it swathes across your tongue. Essence of blackberry, rich bacon fat, campfire smoke and crushed black mineral.
